### 2019 Adult Educator/ Mentor\* of the Year

This award recognises an individual for their outstanding service and contribution to the delivery and support of adult learning programs.

Please address all points in the selection criteria within the specified word counts.

\*For the purpose of this Award, a mentor is someone with skills or experience who offers advice, support and guidance to assist the learning and development of a less experienced person, and empowers them to reach their full potential. The mentor may take on the role of being a role model, trusted advisor, coach, and teacher to their mentee.

\*\*Nominations received from the community education sector will be considered favourably.

#### Selection criterion 1

##### Successful individual or team learning (max. 500 words)

- Describe how the nominee uses their personal skills and abilities and/or vocational qualification to deliver/support quality adult learning programs.
- Describe the educational and employment outcomes that can be linked to the nominee's delivery/support of learning programs.
- Provide an example of the success achieved by the nominee with an individual and/or group of learners.

#### Selection criterion 2

##### Program design and delivery (max. 200 words)

- Describe how the nominee has delivered/supported the delivery of quality adult education programs through their teaching and learning methodologies.

#### Selection criterion 3

##### Level of commitment to adult learning (max. 200 words)

- Describe the professional development that the nominee has undertaken to improve their adult learning knowledge and skills.

#### Supporting documentation

- Statements of support from individuals and/or organisation/s where the nominee has provided outstanding service in adult learning.
- Any other references or learning materials.
