Selection criterion 1

- Describe the education achievements and employment outcomes that resulted from the nominee's learning experiences, including details of their learning pathway.
- Describe the nominee's future learning plans.

Selection criterion 2

Personal skills and abilities (max. 200 words)

• Describe the skills and abilities the nominee has developed that can be attributed to their learning experience.

Selection criterion 3

Other Achievements (max. 200 words)

 Describe other achievements, including assisting others to achieve their learning goals and participation in community development activities.

Supporting documentation

- Testimonials/statements/references from tutors/mentors/ case managers demonstrating evidence of the nominee's skills and learning achievements.
- Any other statements of support or references from other students and/or community members.
