



2019 Adult Learners' Week Award Guidelines

The Department for Innovation and Skills invites nominations for the 2019 Adult Learners' Week Awards.

Adult Learners' Week (ALW) is celebrated every year from 1 – 8
September with a diverse range of events and activities promoting the benefits of learning. The ALW Awards celebrate exemplary individual achievement, and acknowledge the important role of the adult education sector in engaging learners, who may face social and economic barriers, and provide them with pathways to further training, volunteering and employment opportunities.

Nominations are invited from individuals and organisations in the following categories:

Individual Awards

- Adult Learner of the Year
- Aboriginal Learner of the Year
- Adult Educator/Mentor of the Year

Organisation Award

• Adult Learning Program of the Year

Nominations that clearly link back to the Adult Community Education (ACE) program will be considered favourably.

Winners will be announced at the Awards presentation on Thursday 29 August 2019. Award winners receive \$1,000 in prize money, certificate and trophy. Please read the Conditions of Entry carefully before submitting a nomination.

2019 Adult Learners' Week Award Eligibility

Individuals

Eligibility for an individual award is open to any individual who can demonstrate an outstanding achievement as an adult learner or educator. Nominees must clearly demonstrate how they meet all the assessment criteria for the award they are nominating for.

Organisations

Eligibility to nominate for an ALW award is open to any organisation providing adult education and training, including neighbourhood houses, community centres, libraries, training organisations, employers, not for profit organisations, TAFE colleges and universities. Nominations from the community sector will be considered favourably.

Assessment criteria

Each award has its own assessment criteria. Nominee must clearly demonstrate how they meet that criteria and provide evidence to support their nomination. To download selection criteria and conditions of entry visit www.skills.sa.gov.au/alw
