Selection criterion 2

Employment Outcome (max. 200 words)

- Describe the employment outcome that has resulted from the nominee's learning experience, including the impact the employment outcome has had on the nominee's life.

Selection criterion 3

Other Achievements (max. 200 words)

- Describe the skills and abilities the nominee has developed that can be attributed to their learning experience.
- Describe the nominee's future learning plans.

Supporting documentation

- Testimonials/statements/references from tutors/mentors/ case managers demonstrating evidence of the nominee's skills and learning achievements.
- Any other statements of support or references from other students and/or community members.
