Selection criterion 1

Program design and delivery (max. 400 words)

- Describe the program including its primary objective, when and where it was delivered, who it targeted, how it impacted the community it was delivered in, and the outcomes it achieved.
- Describe how the program met client's needs through structure and content.

Selection criterion 2

Learning achievements (max. 200 words)

- Describe the personal skills and abilities and/or vocational skills the program developed in individuals who participated.
- Describe the educational or employment outcomes that can be linked to the delivery of the program.

Selection criterion 3

Other achievements (max. 200 words)

• Describe the other achievements including the consultation process to identify the learning needs of the client group and partnerships with other agencies, groups or organisations in the delivery of the learning program.

Supporting documentation

• Testimonials/references from community members and partner organisations demonstrating the program impact and outcomes for the client group.
